- Call the course Monday morning if you are unable to play so Jim knows. He frequently moves ladies around to keep the course busy.
- You are out there to HAVE FUN!

This Monday, April 15 is our 1st Game of the Season. We are playing "Closest to the Pin" on holes 4 and 9 (the 2 Par 3's). Markers will be set up next to the greens to mark your distances. Rules are pretty simple:

1. Your drive lands on the green

2. Look at the sheet to see if you think your ball is closer than the last marked distance

3. If you think it might be, measure and write your name and the distance on the sheet

- 4. Place the marker back outside the green
- 5. Closest on 4 and 9 win.
- 6. Prize money available the following Monday.

Next Genius Sign Up for May will be opened around 5 PM on **MONDAY.** We have a "Shotgun Start Event" on May 20th with the "2 Person Scramble". Please note that we can only accommodate 72 golfers for this event. That means 2 groups of 4 teeing off on each of the 9 holes. Carol will only have Genius set up to hold 72. If it is full when you try to sign up, let Carol know, she can add you to a "wait list" and if ladies find they are unable to play you will be added. (We have NEVER had a time when everyone who wanted to play wasn't able to, so don't fret.)

When signing up for May 20th, keep this in mind:

- 1. We allow YOU to select your playing partner for this event.
- 2. Talk to your "partner" and only 1 of you sign you both up as a pair.

3. When you go out to Genius, select 2 for the number of players and enter your partner's name.

4. Don't have a "preferred partner", no problem, just sign yourself up and I will pair you up.

I will use these pairs when figuring starting holes. Since you all have done this before (maybe not our new ladies, but they know Genius), it shouldn't be too hard. Problems, let Carol Laupp know or let me know and I will make sure the pair is set up correctly for the event.

We also have a lunch after this Scramble. More info about that later, as our Social Co-Chairs are still working on it. An E-Vite will be be coming about 2 - 3 weeks prior to the event. Cost for the lunch should be \$15, as usual.

Your Officers are meeting, after golf, this coming Monday, April 29 to finalize the Scramble details. The "E-Vite" for lunch after the scramble will be out next week.

On another note, because our numbers have been low, Jim has been getting you ladies out EARLY. That means if you don't arrive, at least, 30 minutes prior to your tee time, you may be playing with different ladies than you signed up with or you MAY NOT GET OUT AT ALL, if the last group has already gone out. We CANNOT expect the golf course to wait to send our groups out at the tee times selected, if that means the course will not be used efficiently. When we get out on the course early, Ballwin can AND WILL start sending out players who are NOT in our league. Keep this in mind when you get ready to on Monday mornings. Thanks so much!

- Anyone who did NOT get their name on either list for the 20th and would like to play, LET ME KNOW ASAP.
 - I will keep a "paper list" as we may have an opening or 2 prior to the 20th and I can get you in.
